Meet Conduct	Current USA Swimming Rules and Tri-County Swim League Rules will govern the meet. <i>Entrance to the pool deck will be limited to those with credentials only.</i>	
Eligibility	All swimmers on the Tri-County Swim League member teams must participate in a minimum of TWO league dual meets <u>for the club they represent</u> before Championship entries are due in order to be eligible for the league championships. "Last Chance" meets do not count. Any Invitational that a Tri-County Swim League team hosts shall count towards the two meet requirement. The Rolling Hills Invitational will also count towards this requirement as long as the swimmer represents his/her Tri-County Swim League team.	
Fees	Entry fees are \$4.00 per individual event and \$12.00 per relay team. Please pay by ONE CHECK made payable to the <u>Tri-County Swim League</u> . No entry fees will be returned. Entry fees shall be brought to the meet. All entry fees must be paid before the meet begins. If full payment is not available, a Request for Check voucher must be submitted.

Entries	All entries shall be electronic and sent via email to the Entries Chairperson. Paper entries will be assessed a \$1/swimmer surcharge. Coaches shall declare all relay names during Championships

- Entry Limits**
- Swimmers may enter three (3) individual events and two (2) relays
 - 6 and under swimmers may also compete in one (1) 8 and under event, excluding the freestyle and backstroke event; however, the total number of individual events may not exceed three.
 - Teams may enter only two relay teams per event
 - There is no limit to the number of swimmers from each team entered in a particular individual event
- ** NT will be acceptable for freestyle and backstroke events ONLY.*
*** NT will not be accepted for any other stroke (Entries will be scratched without notice)*
- Seeding**
- The Tri-County Swim League Championships will be timed finals. Please submit swimmers' best times in short course meters. The eight fastest times will swim in the final heat of each event. In fairness to all swimmers on each of the Tri-County Swim League member teams, the submitted best times should be ones swum during the current season, written to the nearest hundredth of a second. Do not convert. Let Meet Manager do your conversions. If you are using a yard time, simply put Y after the time.
- Up to 15% of the entered times may be asked to be proven. Showing the results from a meet can prove times. Team Manager print-outs are not permitted. Coaches should bring results of their meets to the first session of Championships.
- Clerk of Course**
- There shall be no clerk of course. Each team is responsible for seeing that their swimmers are behind the blocks.
One person per lane will be assigned for all 10/under sessions to help swimmers get in the correct lane and heat.

- Awards**
- Individual events
 - ✓ 1-8 medals and 9-24 ribbons for Division I
 - ✓ 1-8 medals and 9-16 ribbons for Division II
 - Relay events
 - 1-3 medals and 4-8 ribbons
 - Heat winner ribbons will be awarded to the winner of each heat
 - Tri-County Swim League record patches will be given to the swimmer (1) or relay (4) breaking a meet record at Championships
 - Overall team plaques for Division I and Division II
 - Age group plaques will be awarded to each age group, male and female, in both Division I and Division II respectively
 - Divisions shall be determined by the current season's schedule

- Officials**
- The league may hire one starter and one referee, unaffiliated with any team in the Tri-County Swim League
 - Stroke judges and turn judges are to be supplied by the teams in the Tri-County Swim League. It is preferred that stroke and turn judges be certified in USA Swimming, YMCA or High School Swimming. If not certified, stroke and turn judges must attend the swim league's annual clinic and must officiate a minimum of three (3) dual meets during the season prior to Championships.
 - The starter and referee must be certified in USA, YMCA or High School swimming. The starter and referee shall be given an honorarium, amount to be determined by the league executive committee.
 - Officials will be assigned by the meet director prior to the start of championships. These assignments will be based on skill level and availability.

- Other Information**
- 8 and under swimmers will start from the balcony end of the pool
 - No coolers are permitted
 - No outside food or beverages are allowed
 - Shaving down is NOT permitted at the Tri-County Championships
 - Deck changing is NOT permitted at the Tri-County Championships
 - No sleeping bags
 - No lawn chairs
 - Please do not send food with your swimmers on deck.
 - Plastic water bottles are acceptable

- Team Responsibilities**
- Team assignments are based upon previous year's entries
 - Volunteers must check in with the Meet Director the day of the meet
 - Teams not able to fulfill their assignments must make arrangements with other TCSL teams.
 - A \$100 fine will be assessed for missed assignments
 - Supply own clerk of course for Saturday sessions
 - Limit 2 persons at any one time are permitted on deck
 - Supply own watches for timers
